We use a people-first approach. We understand that development is a people-centric process, and that voting is a means, not an end, to choosing the right team. We want to focus on the significance of 'casting one's vote' and its role in enabling society and spur growth and development.

Some of our activities include:

- Sensitising the eligible urban citizens to go for e-registration for obtaining EPIC
- Helping in establishing e-registration counters and providing them necessary guidance
- Conducting voter awareness camps, meetings, rallies etc.,

We seek to work on unbiased, nonpartisan basis without moving into the arena of any preferred political leanings, thus leaving the choice of which party or candidate to vote to, to the educated Indian, as is expected in our democratic process

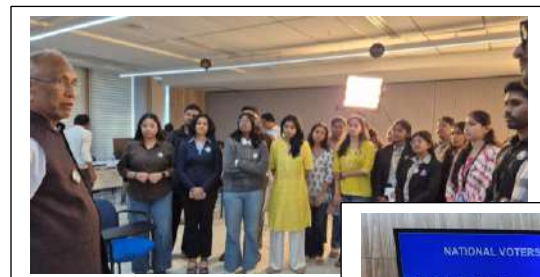

- ◆ SDG 9 – Industry, Innovation & Infrastructure

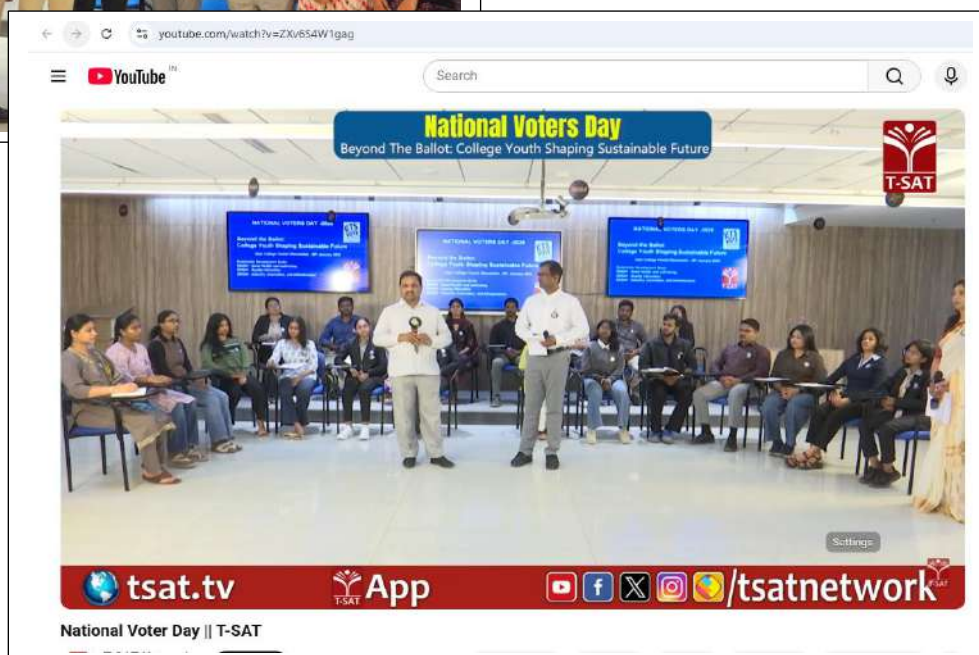

The event stood as a powerful reminder that democracy goes beyond ballots, and that empowered youth are key partners in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. 🇮🇳



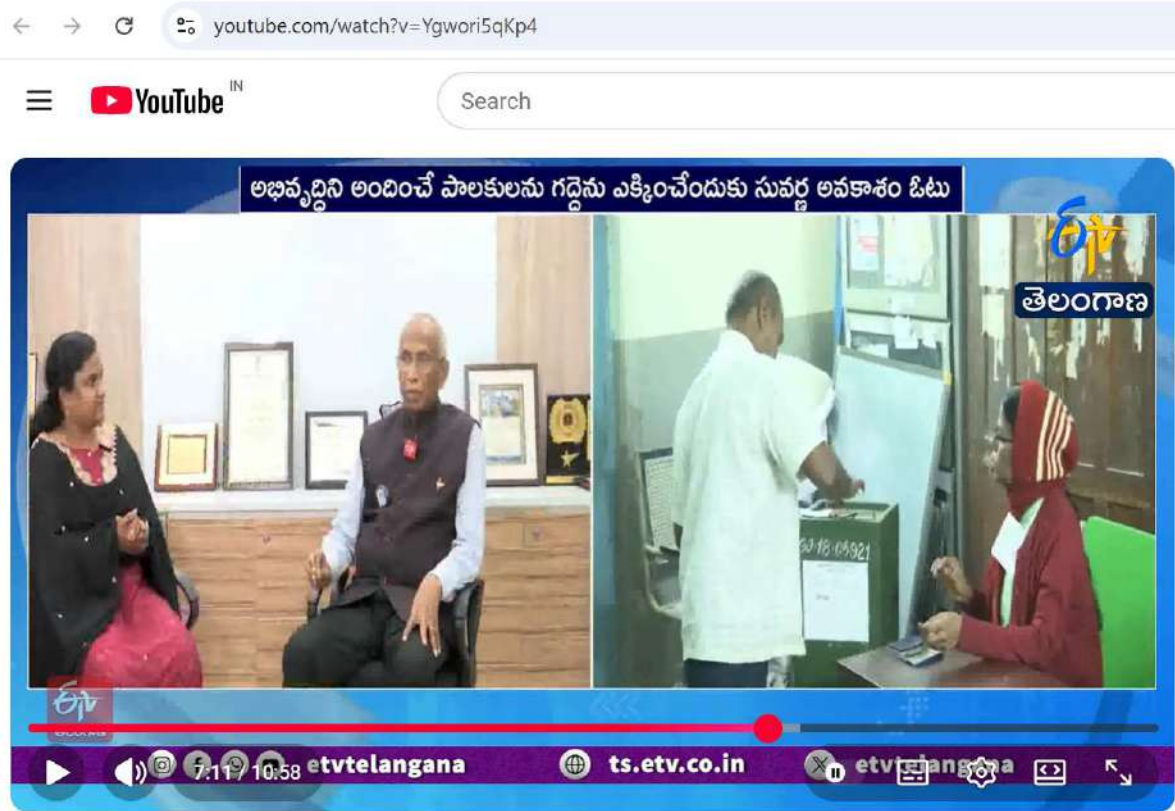
Participation certificates were presented to all student participants, recognizing their contribution and commitment.

Living the Mandate: From Civilizational Ethos to Constitutional Morality

The Constitution Day 2026 programme, themed “Living the Mandate: From Civilizational Ethos to Constitutional Morality,” brought together distinguished academicians, technology leaders, social volunteers, and youth representatives to discuss constitutional morality, democratic responsibility, fundamental rights and duties, and active citizenship. The programme was telecast through digital and social media platforms associated with LETSVOTE outreach initiatives, enabling broader public engagement and awareness.

The event featured participation from Sreenivas Repalle, Founder & CEO of NetShield Technologies and Member of LETSVOTE; Dr. Amaranadha Reddy Manchuri, CEO & Director (R&D), VIRAT Integral R&D Foundation; Preeti Mittal, Founder & CEO of AskLo Community and Volunteer at LETSVOTE; and Aditya Bharadwaj, Volunteer at LETSVOTE. Students, civic volunteers, professionals, and youth from educational institutions actively engaged in the discussions and awareness activities.



Key highlights of the programmes included interactive discussions on constitutional values, awareness sessions on Fundamental Rights and Duties, youth engagement on voting and civic participation, conversations on responsible freedom of speech and digital responsibility, and discussions connecting Bharatiya civilizational ethos with constitutional morality. Speakers emphasized the importance of combating misinformation, strengthening democratic institutions, protecting national sovereignty, and encouraging duty-based citizenship. Participants were encouraged to become informed, responsible, and active contributors towards democracy and nation-building.

The programmes successfully created awareness among students and citizens about constitutional values, voter participation, and civic responsibility, reinforcing the message that democracy is strengthened through active, informed, and ethical public participation.



Alongside these activities, **LetsVote** provided comprehensive **voter services**, including **new registrations**, educating the electors about services provided via NVSP portal and **digital tools** for tracking applications and accessing voter information.

Through a strategic combination of grassroots outreach and digital enablement, LetsVote effectively promoted informed civic participation, reinforced democratic responsibility, and expanded citizen access to electoral services across all age groups.
